ORGAN BURSARY

Minimum standard Grade 6

Minimum age 14

£400 pa

- Suitable primarily for a student's first experience of playing for a service, accompanying an occasional hymn at the start of the year, with the goal of accompanying a whole service after 8 months.
- Must have had experience playing in public eg school concert, or voluntary at beginning or end of a service
- Must be engaged in regular ongoing organ lessons
- Experience offered with chorister training for suitable candidate
- Must be able and willing to accompany Youth Choir occasionally (on piano/keyboard)

- Must be able to work as part of a team including Rector, Director of Music, Deputy Director of Music, Assistant Organist, Chorister Assistant and Youth Choir Leader
- Essential to see themselves as part of the choir and to attend all Friday evening choir practices and Sunday services (9.30 and 6.30) during term-time and at major festivals
- Offered competitively after audition
- Auditions in early September for post beginning in November 2009
- Reference from organ teacher
- Reference from Head of Music or Head Teacher



ORGAN SCHOLARSHIP

Minimum standard Grade 8

Minimum age 16

£600 pa

- Suitable for an undergraduate or Sixth-Former who has had occasional experience accompanying hymns and anthems, but wants to extend their ability and occasionally accompany whole services, with the aim of applying for a university organ scholarship
- Must be engaged in regular ongoing organ lessons
- Must be willing to take part in chorister training
- Occasional experience conducting choir offered to suitable candidate
- Must be able and willing to accompany Youth Choir occasionally
- Must be able to work as part of a team including Rector, Director of Music, Deputy Director of Music, Assistant

Organist, Chorister Assistant
and Youth Choir Leader

- Essential to see themselves as part of the choir and to attend all Friday evening choir practices and Sunday services (9.30 and 6.30) during term-time and at major festivals
- Offered competitively after audition
- Auditions in early September for post beginning in November 2009
- Reference from organ teacher
- Reference from minister/priest or senior lecturer/professor
