### Illuminated Remembrance Service at Wimbledon Windmill on the Evening of 11th November 2018

The Wimbledon and Putney Commons Conservators are holding a very special Commemoration Service as part of Battle's Over, an international commemoration marking 100 years since the guns fell silent at the end of World War I. The service will consist of a lone piper, solo trumpeter and an illuminated display of poppies, images and names of those who sacrificed their lives on the sails of the Wimbledon Windmill. After a short reading, bells will be rung out across the country. Please meet at the Wimbledon War Memorial at 18:00hrs, from where a procession to the Wimbledon Windmill will be led by Stephen Hammond MP for the start of the Commemoration Service at 18:30hrs. (Please wear appropriate footwear and bring a torch and hand bell.) The event will end at 19:30hrs.
